The swim test can be taken at any pool where a lifeguard is present. We do not administer swim tests at the boathouse. Please print the form and have a lifeguard sign it. Please bring the form with you to your first day of the rowing session. You will not be boated without the swim test. See list of resources below*

Requirements are, per US Rowing recommendations:

Swim 50 yds without stopping

Tread water for 10 min.

Put on a lifejacket on, while in the deep end, where treading water, and swim to the shallow end.

Complete the form, make a copy for your records and bring the form to the boathouse on the first day of the program.
